State Show Information Sheet 2017

1. You must be 13 as of January 1, 2017
2. You must submit a handwritten 2 page essay on the topic, Submit a personal photograph of the horse you are showing and write about that photograph and what it means to you.
3. You must spend 4 hours working at a designated show as community service. Sign up for your choice on your class sheet.
4. Pay a \$20 non-refundable fee due May 1 to help defray the cost.
5. In needed the qualifier show will be on Sunday, June 25 beginning at 9:00 a.m. Exhibitors must be present by 8:45 a.m. or they will be disqualified.
6. Class registration sheet is due May 1. Only choose 6 classes. Two of our allotted spots will be gymkhana riders. If you are one of the 2 chosen you must choose gymkhana classes for state.
7. Point system is in the Van Buren Youth Fair Horse and Pony Rules.
8. Chosen state show participants MUST work the cleanup the Tuesday after the fair at 6:00 p.m. Conflicts must be resolved by the last day of the fair.
9. Hunter hack participants must have their jumping forms in.
10. If you are chosen, you must have a copy of your coggins, be prepared to choose your state show classes and pay the entry fee (around \$60) on the qualifier day. If the qualifier show is not held all State Show exhibitor must a meeting at 6 p.m. on June 7th to complete paper. Bounced checks will void your spot. One alternate will fill out paperwork.
11. Parents are EXPECTED to work at the qualifying show opening gates, setting up patterns, etc.
12. Defacing public property will not be tolerated.
13. You must have participated in one (1) fair within the last two (2) years.
14. Horse Council reserves the right to cancel or postpone the show.
